

Downloadable eBooks and audiobooks

Effective May 16th, 2017, Overdrive will no longer be available for downloadable eBooks and audiobooks for BCCLS patrons. All titles will be accessible through cloudLibrary only. Making the change provides a more user-friendly experience and allows individual libraries to purchase their own content. Overdrive will be turned off May 15th, any holds or titles checked out on Overdrive **will expire and not be transferred to cloudLibrary**. The following devices will continue to be supported:

- Android devices (phones and tablets)
- iOS devices (phones and tablets)
- Kindle Fire (2nd generation or newer - no other Kindle devices are supported) *
- Kobo
- Nook tablets & ereaders
- PCs, Macs, & Chromebooks

***Will I be able to use my Kindle eInk reader?**

Unfortunately, no. Amazon does not support the ePub format used by the cloudLibrary platform, and Overdrive currently has an exclusive deal with Amazon to support the Kindle ebook format.

If you have not used cloudLibrary (formerly 3M) before, you need to first download the cloudLibrary app from your device's app store.
