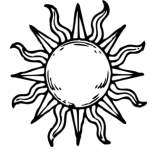

WWI: The Great War, 100 Years Later

Sunday, June 11th at 2 p.m.

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the United States' entry into World War I. In this program, we will consider how the United States, originally a neutral nation, got involved in Great War. The Zimmerman Telegram, trench warfare and how new military weapons affected the outcome of the War will also be discussed. President Woodrow Wilson's policy of nonintervention and peacemaking attempts during and after the Treaty of Versailles and the lost generation of German, French and English men will round out the program.

Tuesday, June 20th at 1 p.m.

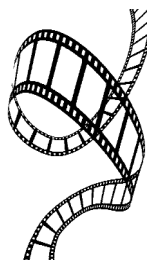

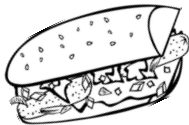
